2018 Summer Camps

VERDURE Summer Camps are for ages 5 to 11 years old

Camp Week Registration:

Members can register for camp one week at a time or may register for all 10 weeks. Any camper registered for 7 or more camps will receive a 10% discount on all camps for which they are enrolled. To receive this discount registration must be received for all camps prior to the start of the first camp. A \$50 non-refundable deposit for each camper and each camp is required at the time of registration. Any remaining balance will be due in full by May 14th 2018. We have a max number of 20 kids per week, so register now before camps fill up!

Normal Camp hours will be from 8:30am-9:00am (drop off time) to 4:00pm-4:30pm (pick up time). We are offering early drop off and late pick up for parents who need a little extra time to come pick up their kiddos, each at an additional cost of \$15.

Camp week descriptions:

Sports- Kids will have a chance to experience several sport themed activities: Basketball, soccer, volleyball, football, and frisbee.

Circus- Kids will experience fun activities outside all themed towards circus/carnival games.

Obstacle Course- Kids will go through several courses created by VERDURE camp staff. They will race themselves and as teams.

Field Day- Kids will have fun games outside working in teams to create a team building environment.

Mad Science- Kids will make their own creation using everyday items and of course SCIENCE!

Harry Potter- All activities will be around Harry Potter. We will create a Quidditch Pitch for the end of camp week.

Beach- Kids will experience activities towards beach games and water.

Drop off and pick up procedures:

A completed/signed VERDURE Summer Camp Registration form with alternate contact and authorization pick up sections must be submitted. Only the listed individuals will be authorized to pick up campers.

Authorized individuals must enter the facility to officially sign in and sign out the child as no child can sign themselves out of camp.

**After 5:30pm our late fee policy is as follows:

\$10: 6 to 14 minutes late

\$20: 15 to 29 minutes late

\$50: 30 to 59 minutes late

Camp Location:

Check-in and Pick-up will be located just inside the door to the right of the main entrance when facing the building.

Primary areas of use: racquetball court, KidZone, outdoor turf field, outdoor pool, outdoor park and grassy areas (areas adjacent to Town Square Apartments), and Golf Simulator.



Camp down payment:

A non-refundable \$50 deposit is required for each camp week a child is planning to attend. Your child's spot is not guaranteed until deposit is received. All remaining balance towards camp will need to be paid in full by May 14th 2018 at 5:00pm.

Lunches and snacks:



Snacks: All campers will receive an afternoon snack

- Members may purchase lunches for the week for \$25 (\$5 per day Mon-Fri) from the VERDURE Café. These lunches will include: entrée, side item, and drink. Lunch option will need to be purchased when registering for camp weeks.
- If a parent forgets to pack a child's lunch a \$7 charge will be billed to the members account.
- Lunches from home: Child may bring their own lunch and drink in a labeled cooler/bag to camp every day. Lunches should be ready-to-eat as there will not be access to a microwave or refrigerator.

Campers should bring their own water bottle to use throughout the day

First Aid and emergency procedures:

Call all or appropriate emergency services.

Contact parents/guardians.

Stabilize injured child.

First aid kits available.

Medication(s):

All medication(s) that need to be taken during camp hours must be given to a VERDURE camp staff member.

Medications must be in their original container

A VERDURE medication administration form must be completed and signed by parent/legal guardian specifying administration, frequency, dosage, and timing.

Dress code:

Bring clothing appropriate for outdoor play and daily weather conditions.

Sandals permitted, however, close toed shoes should be brought in case of special activities.

Swim suits should be brought separate from other camp apparel.

Campers must bring their own towel for pool use.

Discipline Policy:

Camp will operate on a "three-strike" system of discipline.

Strike 1: Verbal warning to a child from camp staff/ Time out

Strike 2: Both parent and youth manager notified.

Strike 3: Asked to leave camp for the rest of the day.
